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Hotel de abejas

Un hotel de abejas es una estructura con cavidades huecas que permite que diferentes especies de abejas solitarias tengan un hogar. Dentro de las 20.000 especies de abejas que existen en el mundo, existe un grupo conocido como abejas sin aguijón o meliponinos. En Costa Rica existen aproximadamente 60 especies de abejas sin aguijón y unas 800 especies de abejas en total.

Este hotel de abejas sin aguijón permite que distintas especies de abejas puedan repoblar áreas sensibles, así contribuimos con su conservación.

Tetragonisca angustula (Mariola)

Abeja sin aguijón *Tetragonisca angustula* conocida como Mariola o mariaseca en Costa Rica, habita entre los 0 y 1600 metros a nivel del mar habitando en gran parte del país.
